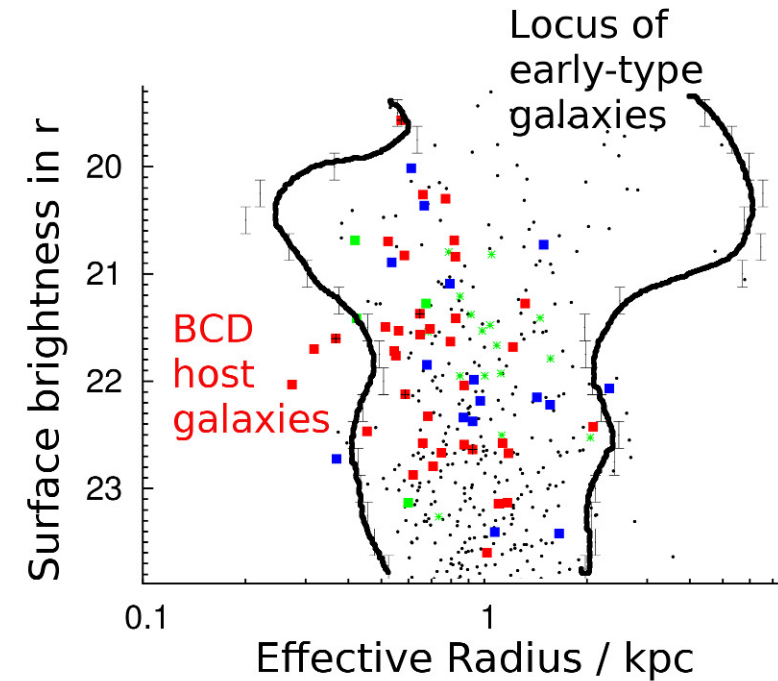

40 Virgo cluster galaxies were classified as BCDs.

They are structurally similar to early-type dwarfs when subtracting the starburst.

If the starburst does not last longer than a few 100 Myr, early-type dwarfs and BCDs must be "oscillating" based on population arguments!
